## Proposed Addition to Kern Community College District Board Policy Manual Section Six – Certificated Academic Senate

Policy 6H

Governance Process: Rely Primarily Upon

Reason for Addition: To Amend District Policy

6H Adjunct Employment (See Procedure 6H)

- 6H1 The Board of Trustees shall appoint all adjunct faculty to provide instruction or services for the District.
- 6H2 All adjunct appointments by the Board of Trustees shall be provided by the Administration which will involve the active participation and recommendation of faculty.
- 6H3 The District shall adopt administrative procedures for hiring adjunct faculty who meet the following criteria:
  - a. <u>meet state mandated discipline Minimum Qualifications or</u> <u>meet criteria to receive an equivalency for the discipline as</u> <u>determined by an Academic Senate Equivalency committee.</u>
  - b. <u>demonstrate subject area knowledge and competency.</u>
  - c. <u>be skilled in teaching and serving the needs of a diverse</u> <u>student population.</u>
  - d. <u>show potential for overall professional effectiveness.</u>
  - e. <u>communicate effectively.</u>
  - f. <u>demonstrate a sensitivity to the ethnic and cultural diversity</u> <u>of our communities.</u>
- 6H4 It is the responsibility of the Human Resources office to establish and maintain applicant pools for Adjunct hiring. To the extent possible, the

- adjunct pools shall have applicants in all disciplines the college provides for the District.
- 6H5 Unless an emergency situation exists, the Department/Division administrator shall offer adjunct employment only to candidates from these adjunct faculty hiring pools.
- 6H6 The Human Resources office at each College is responsible for monitoring, training, and consulting College administration, faculty, and staff involved with the recruitment and screening process for adjunct faculty.
- 6H7 Nothing in this Policy or District Administrative Procedure shall violate federal or state laws governing personnel employment.
