Culinary Arts and Food Management programs in 2011-2012 went from 6 AA/AS degrees 2010-2011 to 17 AA/AS degrees in 2011-2012

Child Development program went from 22 AA/AS degrees in 2010-2011 to 44 AA/AS degrees in 2011-2012. Also, all Child Development certificates issued in 2020-2011 were 150 and in 2011-2012 there were 224
