MEMBERSHIP	Co-Chaired by VP, Academic Affairs /Faculty Co-chair (will also serve on Academic Senate Exec Board) <u>5 Administrators</u> : selected from Student Services, Research, Facilities, Instruction, IT <u>2 Classified Representatives</u> : appointed by CSEA <u>8 Faculty</u> : appointed by the Academic Senate – Assessment Co-chair, Program Review Committee Co-chair; five (5) from areas directly related to one or more of the accreditation standards (Library, CTE, General Education, Basic Skills, and Student Services); and one (1) at-large member.
