**Credit for Prior  
Learning: an  
overview**

- College credit awarded for validated college-level skills and knowledge gained outside of a college classroom:
  - Military training
  - Industry training
  - State/federal government training
  - Apprenticeships, internships, work-based learning, or other industry-based experiential learning
  - Validated volunteer and civic activities (e.g. Peace Corps)
- Purview of faculty as discipline experts

## Credit for Prior Learning: an overview

- **CPL eligible course will have different methods of assessment, which may include one or more of the following:**
  - **Military Transcript**
  - **Industry Certification**
  - **Credit by Exam**
  - **Portfolio Review**
  - **Industry Accreditation or License**
  - **AP, IB, CLEP**

**Update of  
CPL at  
BC**

- **CCR Title 5 §55050**
  - By December 31, 2020, the district shall certify in writing to the Chancellor of the California Community Colleges that the policies required by this section have been adopted and implemented:
    - 1) Submission of the CPL policy language, and
    - 2) Districts to confirm that each community college campus within the district has posted its CPL policy in the college catalog and on its Web site.
