Accomplishments

- SLO/PLO review in eLumen for 2020-21: 343 courses and 39 programs reviewed by committee
- 2020-21 SLO assessment plans: 79 / 79 = 100% updated and posted to committee website
- Progress towards updating SLO-ILO and SLO-GELO mappings: 415 / 619 courses = 67.0% completed
- Updated Program Review Assessment Report in eLumen for 2021-22
- Survey regarding ILO #4 (engage) closed 3/19 with 1,351 students participating; OIE is currently working to analyze and visualize the results
- Created [SLO Completion Tableau](#) to visualize SLO assessments submitted in eLumen by course and term; Assessment Committee voted and unanimously approved on 3/19
- Created [ILO Performance Tableau](#) to visualize performance of students meeting the four ILOs based on SLO assessment data in eLumen and SLO-ILO mappings
 - A proposal to AIQ Committee was submitted on 3/9 with four ILO performances to be included as a measure of student learning in BC's Institution-Set Standards (ISS)
