- First meeting was Sept. 16<sup>th</sup>
- Committee Charge was updated, revision voted on in Sept. 30<sup>th</sup> meeting.
  - Title changes/removed CTE & basic skills faculty/add one more classified
  - Restructured faculty membership to have representation at department (pathway?) level
    - Rationale
      - increase faculty participation in EMC
      - EMC will regularly communicate out enrollment updates and strategies; and
      - hopes to bring in departmental questions and concerns.

- Use starfish to find students who had dropped one or more courses
- Ocelot used to contact targeted students to ask
  - 1) why they dropped
  - 2) would they be interested in the same course as a late start
- This provides specific information for late start course demand.
