Section 3 Terms of Office

a. A Senator shall serve for a term of two consecutive years.

b. One-half of the Senators shall be elected annually.

c. If it becomes necessary to temporarily replace a Senator
("original Senator" in this section), the Department may select
their interim replacement subject to confirmation by the Senate
(rep.). Failing either, the position will remain vacant until the next
regularly scheduled election. The interim Senator would serve
until the original Senator is able to resume their duties or until the
next regularly scheduled election, whichever comes first.

A copy of this policy will be emailed to the <u>original</u> senator, the <u>Department</u> Chair, and the department secretary. The <u>original</u> <u>Senator</u> or 2nd <u>Senator</u> from the area and chair will work together to find a replacement, and the <u>Department</u> Chair will notify the Senate Office.

d. Vacancies occurring at irregular times shall be filled by a special election within thirty days after the vacancy occurs, in accordance with the nomination and election procedures.

e. When any <u>Senator</u> is incapable of performing the duties outlined below, the President shall conduct an election of that <u>Senator's</u> <u>Department</u> according to the nomination and election rules to determine a successor.
