## Okta

Brett Redd provided an OKTA update. The district is researching all of the fraudulent enrollments. It has been something that has been brought to light with the use of this system. Although everyone doesn't seem to like using Okta, he expressed that it is our authentication for now.

## Committee Charge

Accessibility was discussed as a point to be included in the charge.

A small group was formed to compile the language and will be presented at the next ISIT meeting.

## Committee Goals and Role

The current Bakersfield College Technology Plan sunsets this year. A new Technology Plan will need to be implemented to start in 2023 and will sunset in 2025. This responsibility falls to the IT team.

Brett Redd highlighted the basic goals of the 2021-2023 plan, which included:

- COVID Work from Home
- Wireless Infrastructure Improvement both indoors and outdoors.
- Phase III will begin next year which will cover the AG farm and the parking lot in front of the Library.

## Media Specialist and Video Production

There is no longer the Media Specialist position in Technology Services.

Additionally, the responsibility of video production now sits with Marketing.

# Construction Update

- Administrative Services (former bookstore) came online in July. Marketing, Institutional Research, Scheduling, Human Resources, College Safety, and Student Health Center have all moved into the facility.
- The automotive Classroom location for the new CTE training program is operational and teaching classes.
- Renegade Athletics/Gym is another year out, due to setbacks with the pool buildings. They are no longer part of the project.
- Delano Learning Resources Center will be completed by late spring 2023.
- Remodel of Math/Science Building for Allied Health will begin in spring 2023.

# Strategic Directions

Brett shared the strategic goals with the committee. One of the largest roles of ISIT deals with access to Wifi.

- Zoom Area in Library computer commons. 22 computers are set up.
- Vision Resource Center will be the new location to register for Academic Technology Workshops. It was implemented during fall Flex Week.
