## What is NACCC?



- The National Assessment of Collegiate Campus Climate (NACCC) is a quantitative national survey of undergraduate students.
- 15-minute web-based survey that includes six content areas
  - Mattering and Affirmation
  - Cross Racial Engagement
  - Racial Learning and Literacy
  - Encounters with Racial Stress
  - Appraisals of Institutional Commitment
  - Impact of External Environments
- Developed and administered by the USC Race and Equity Center

Chancellor Christian and Dean Hayward serve on the *30-member Racial Equity in Guided Pathways Commission* at USC Race and Equity Center.

# What is the CCSSE?



- The Community College Survey of Student Engagement (CCSSE) is a quantitative national survey of community college students.
- What is Student Engagement?
  - “...the amount of time and energy students invest in meaningful educational practices
  - ...the institutional practices and student behaviors that are highly correlated with student learning and retention”
- Developed and administered by Center for Community College of Student Engagement (CCCSE) Center at the University of Texas at Austin

NACCC was administered to BC students (N=22,792) in **Spring 2021**

In total, **1,442** students participated in the survey (6.3% response rate)

- CCSSE was administered to BC students in **Spring 2022**
  - 109 classes were randomly selected for in-class administration

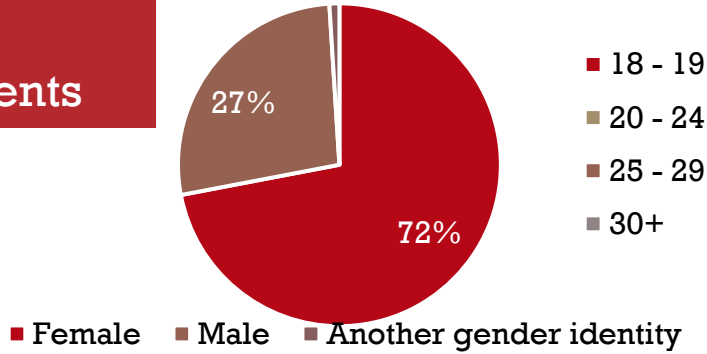
In total, **1,348** students participated in the survey (55% response rate & 90% of target sample size)



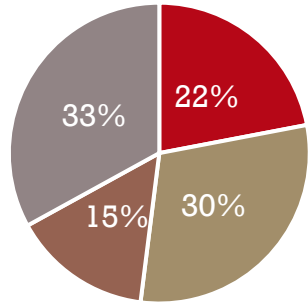

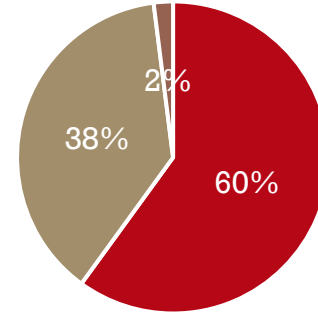
### Gender Identity



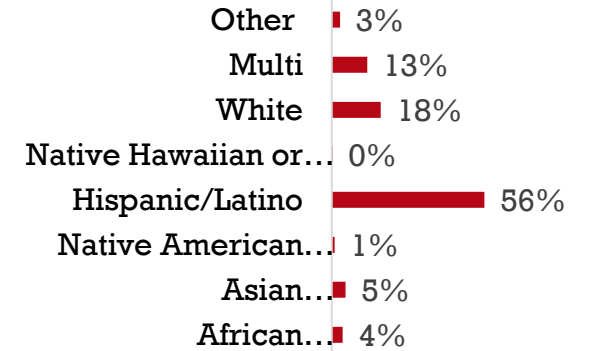
### Age Groups

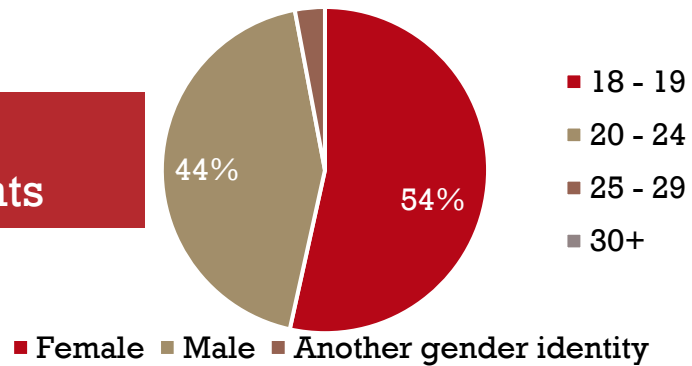

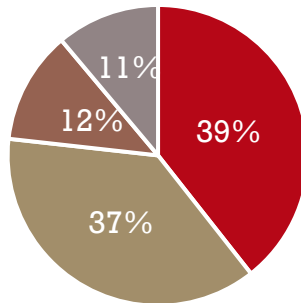

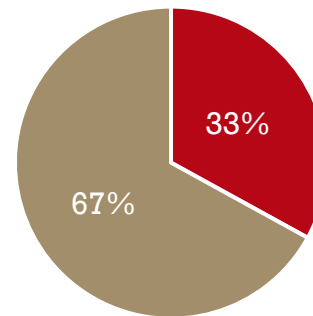

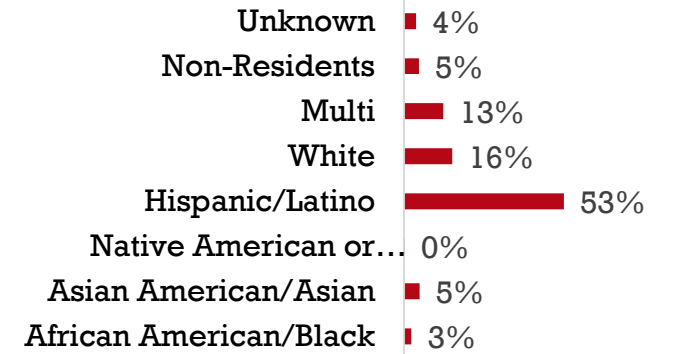

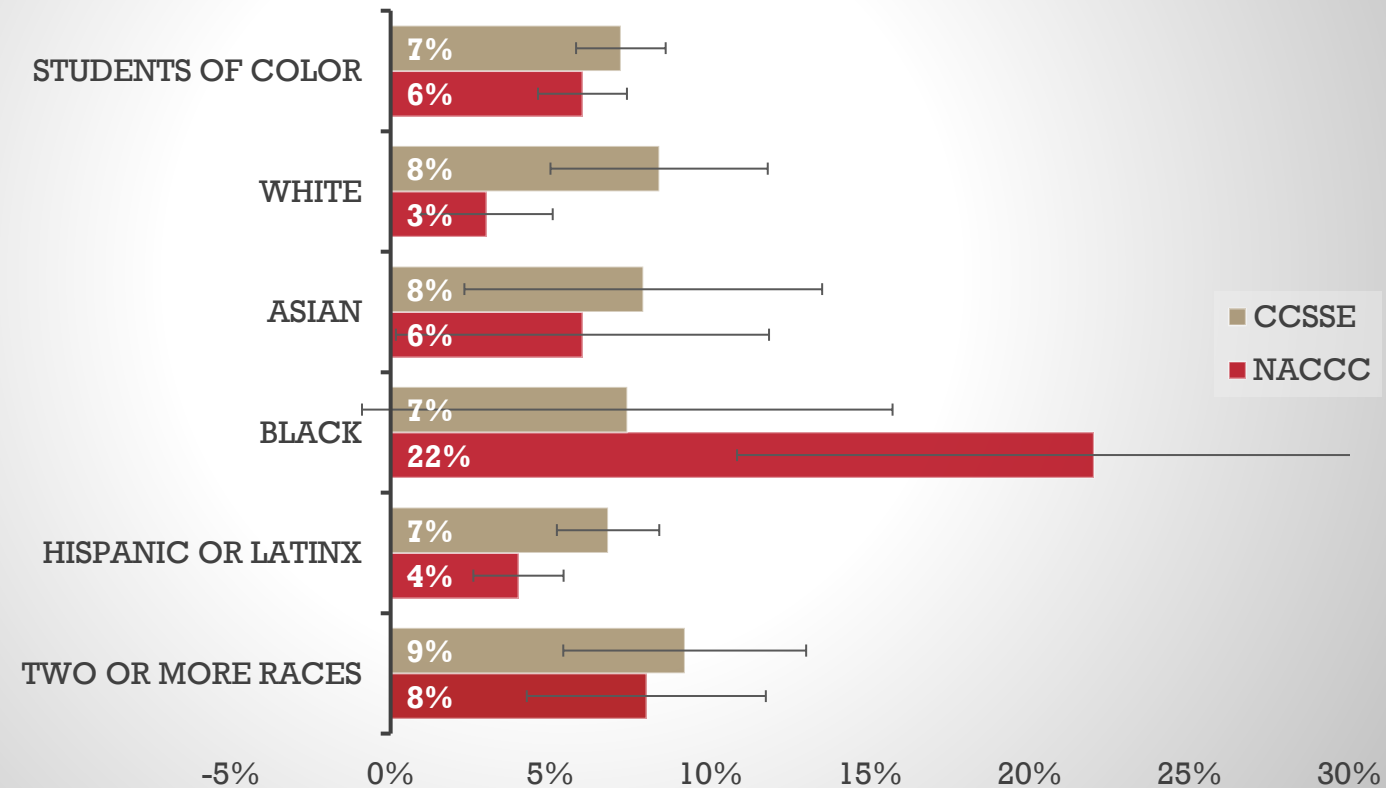

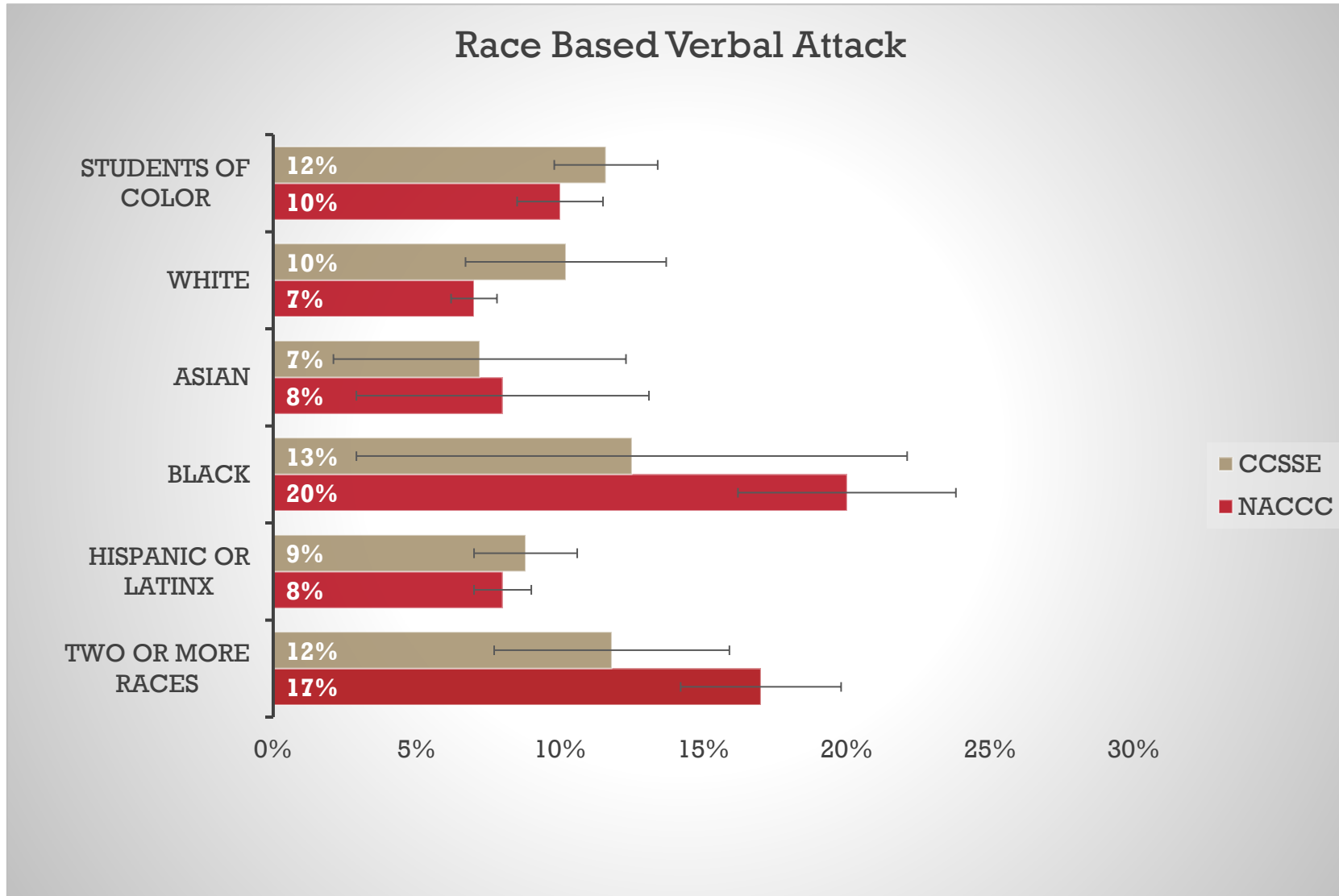

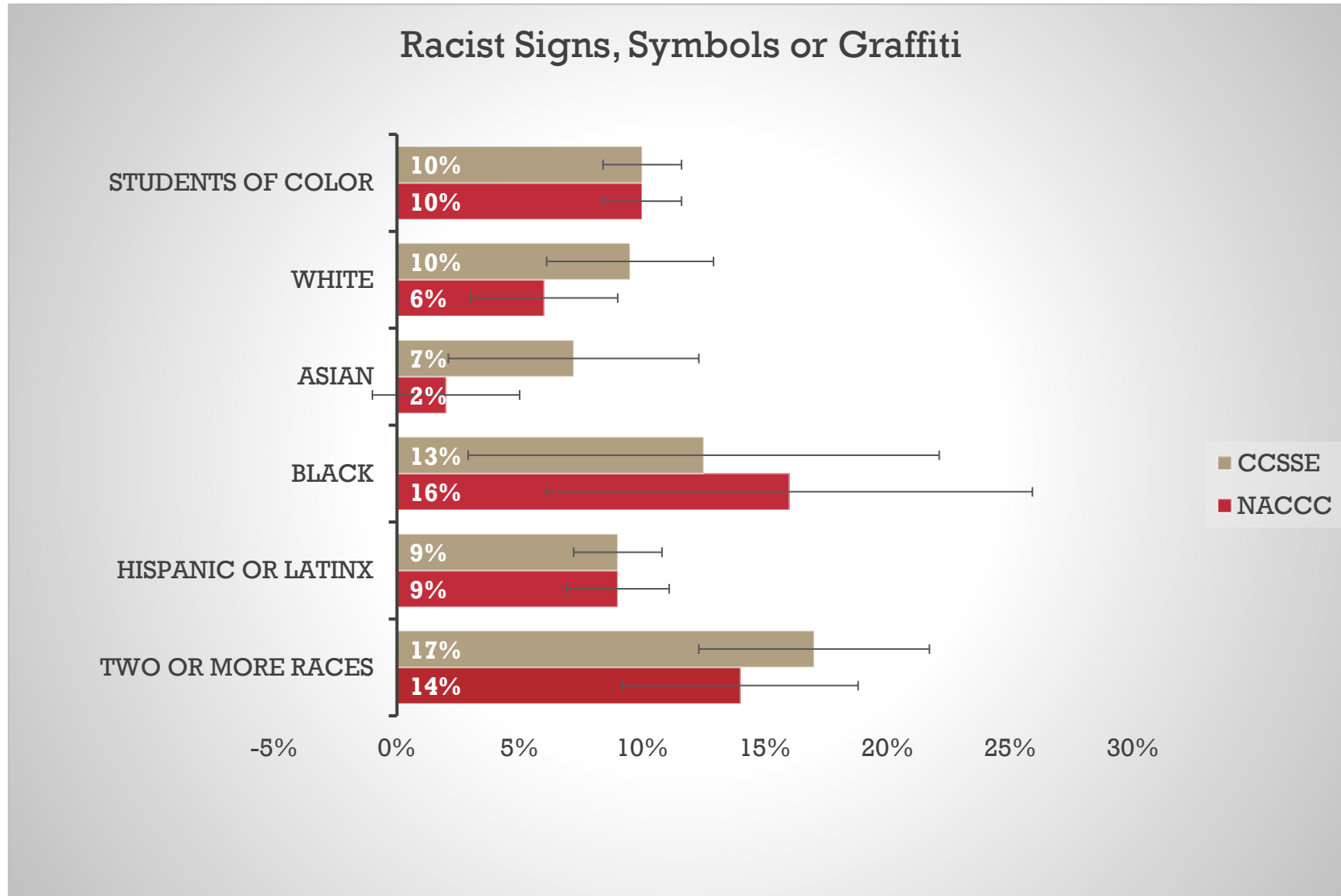

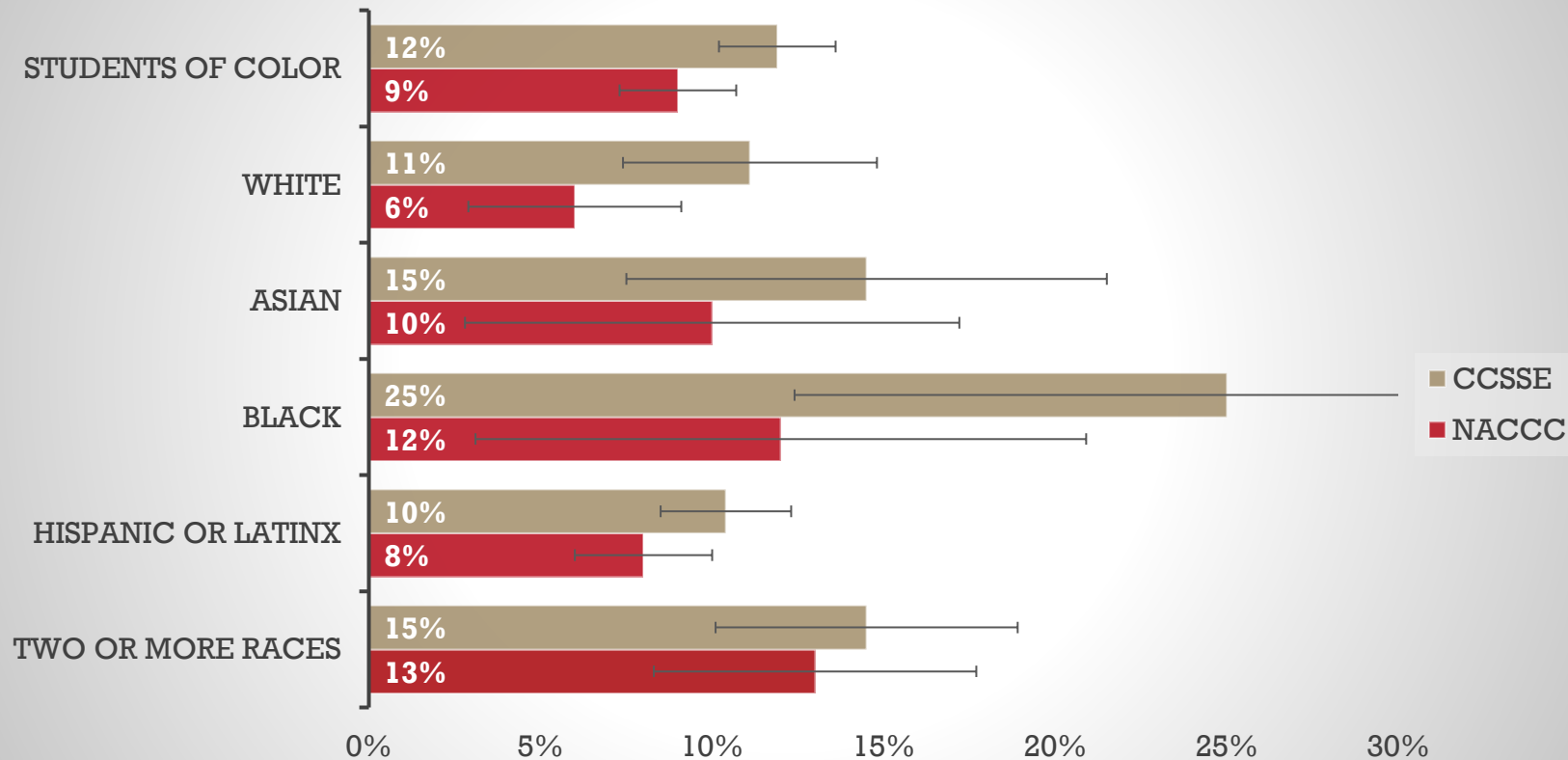

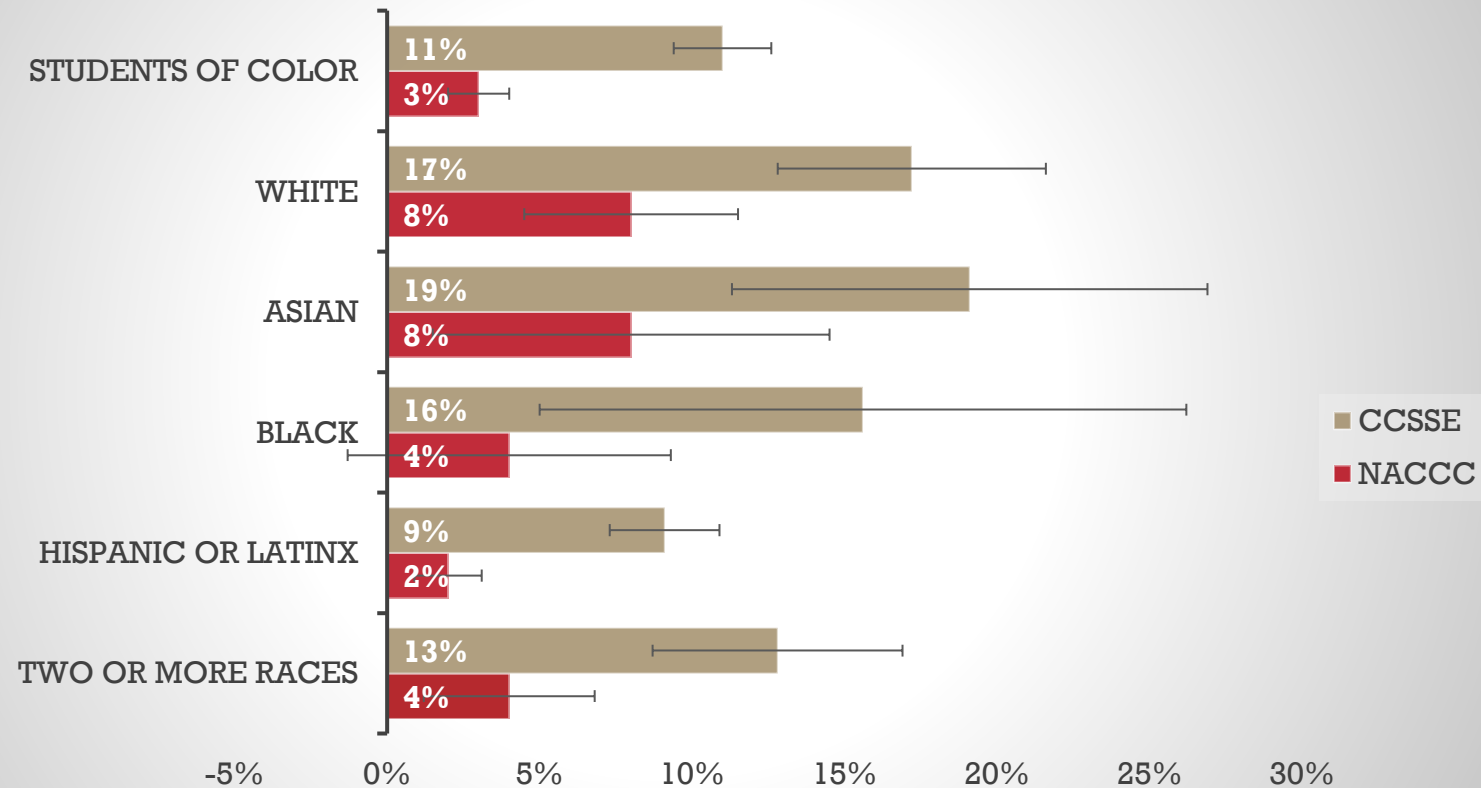

## Jokes Related to Race that Make You Uncomfortable



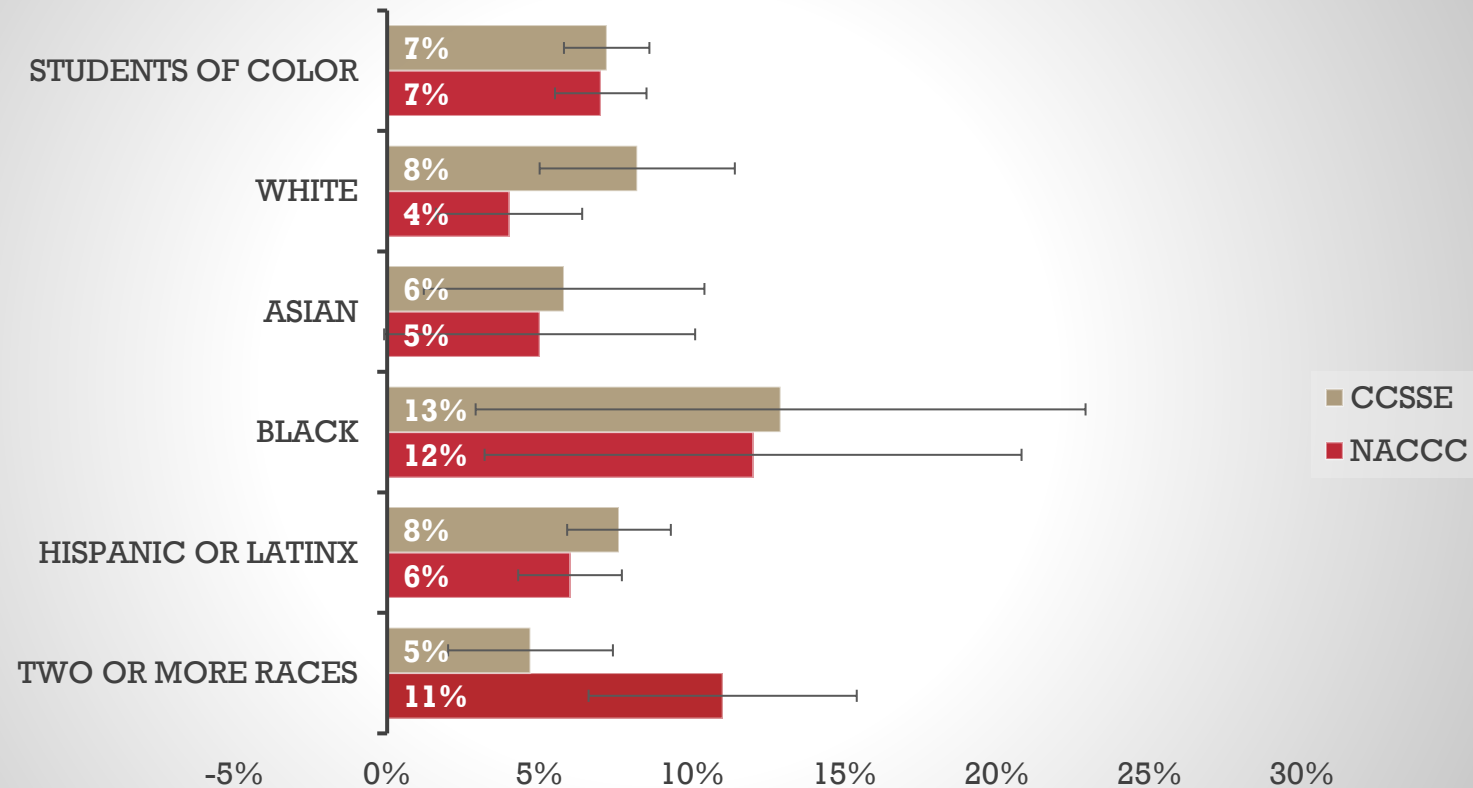

## Being Viewed as Naturally More Able Than Others in Classes

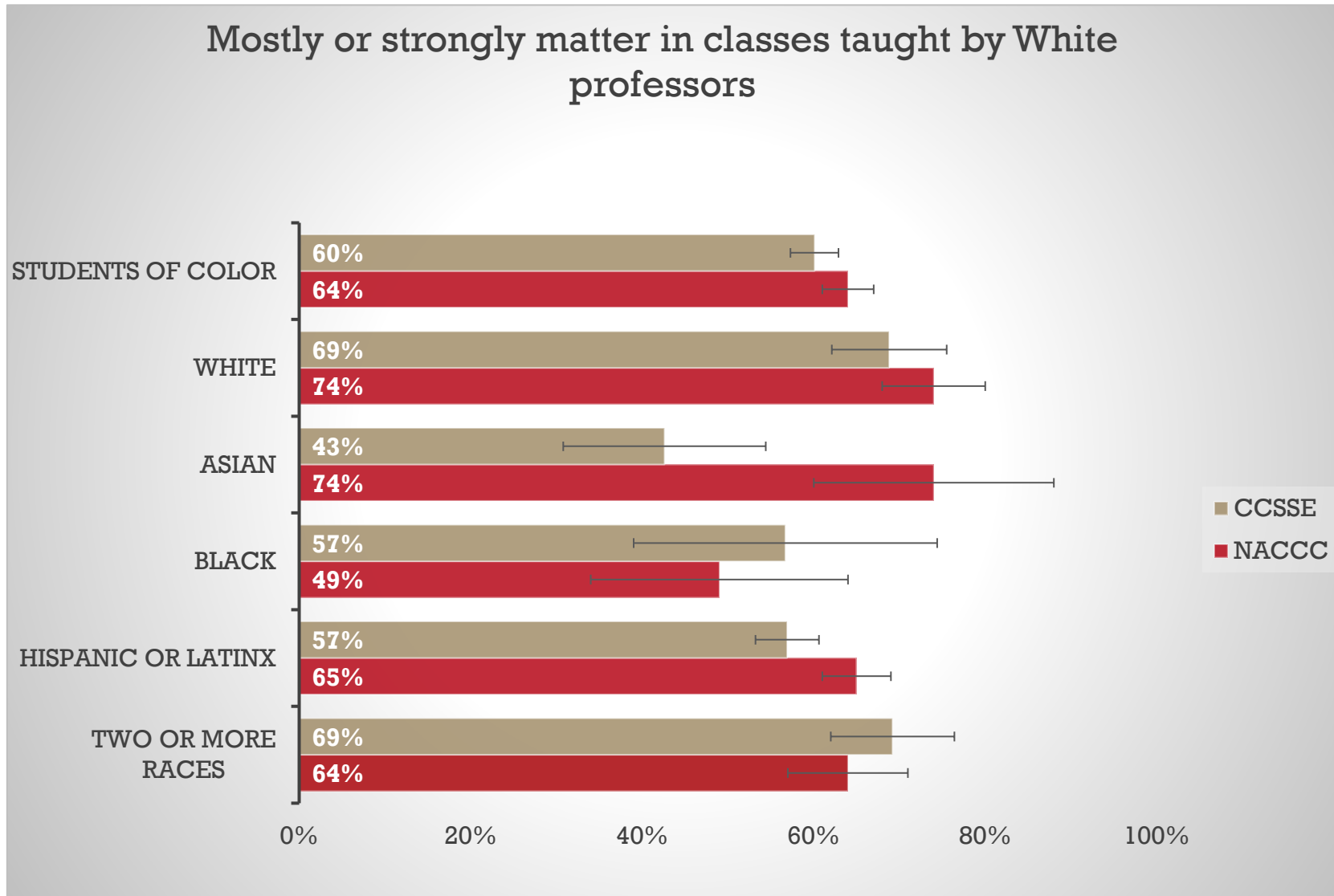

Being Viewed as Naturally Less Able Than Others in Classes

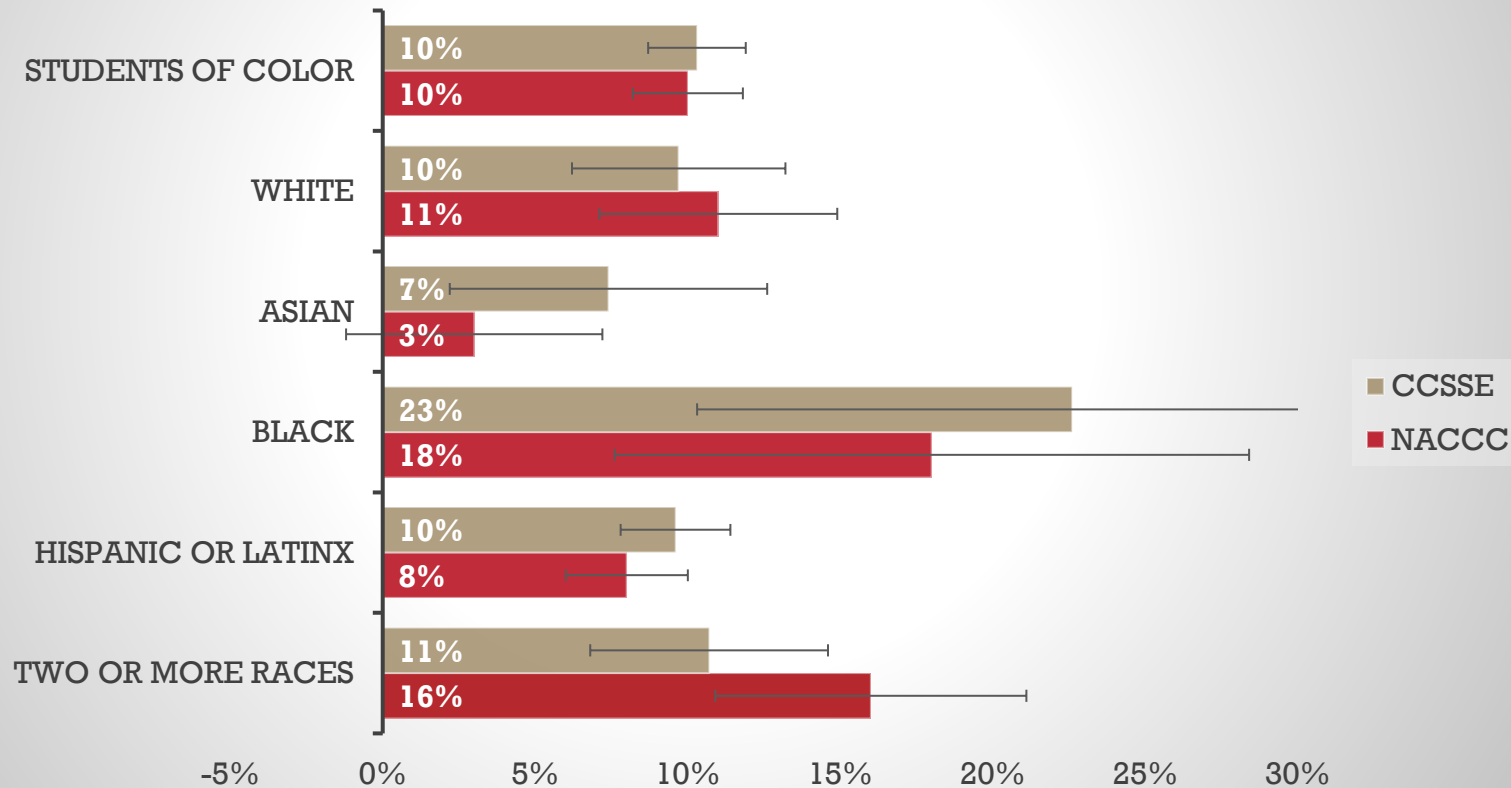


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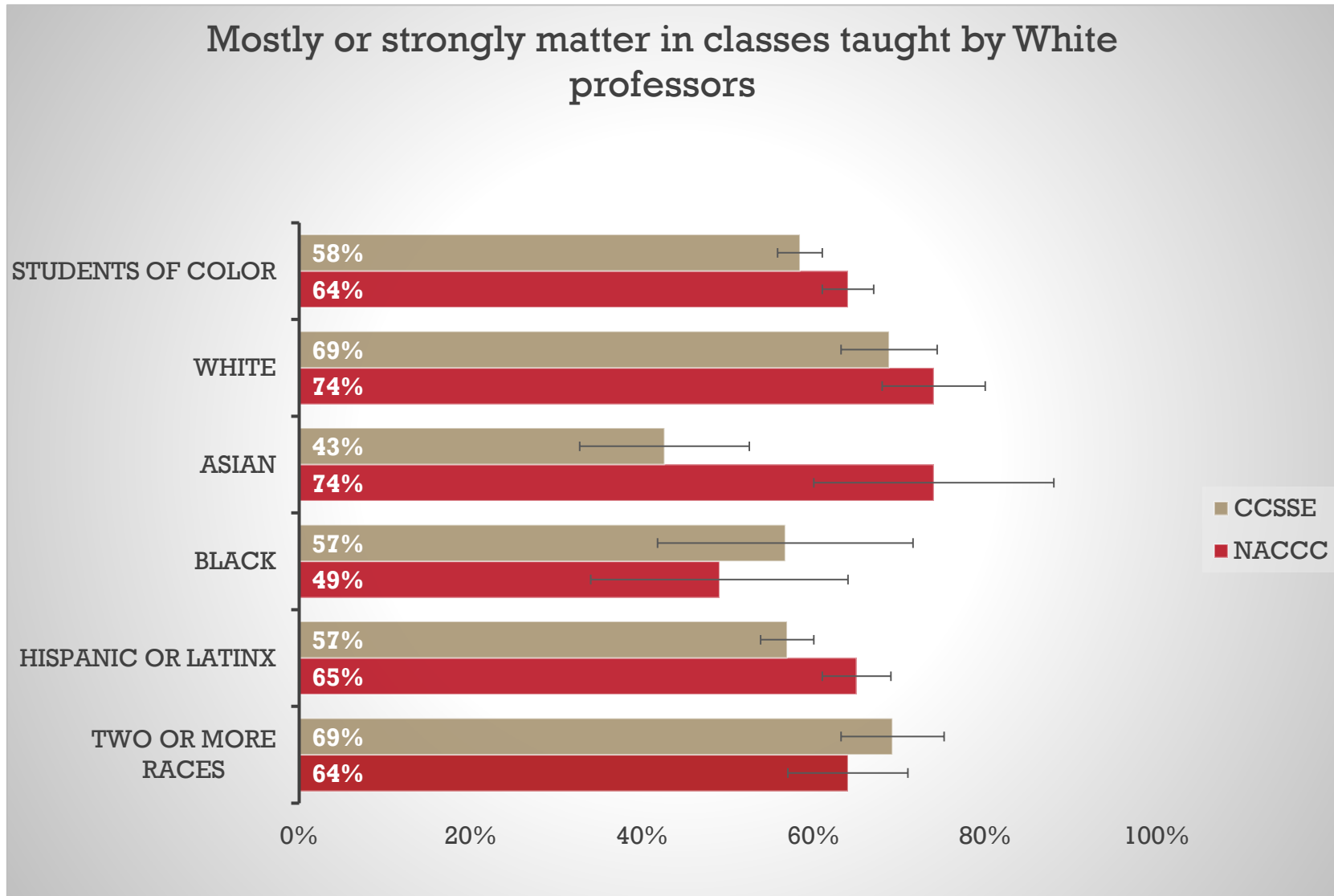


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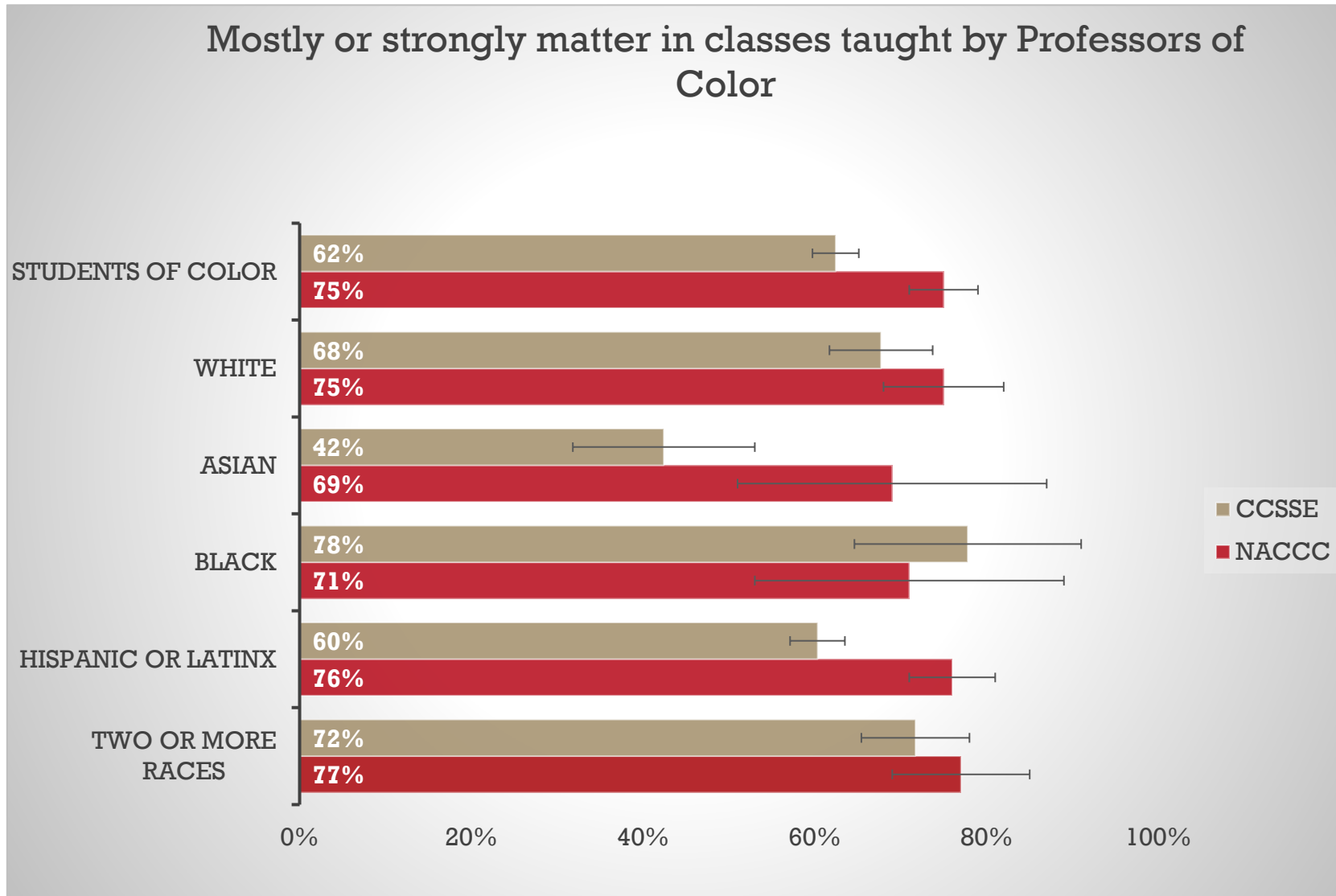
