

Assessment Report to Academic Senate

- Assessment's last meeting was October 21.
 - We voted to approve the [ILO 2 Assessment Report](#) for publication. This report is now available on the [Institutional Learning Outcome Assessment](#) page.
 - [Tableau](#) data shows that the average percentage of students that met or exceeded expectations in courses mapped to ILO 2 from 2018-2021 is 88.44%.
 - Of the 20 artifacts submitted to Assessment that demonstrated assessment of communication in a course, 94.8% had student work to achieve these assessments that met or exceeded expectations.
 - We determined that we will assess ILO 3: Demonstrate during the 2022-2023 year.
- On November 18, the Curriculum Co-Chairs and the Articulation Officer will speak with the committee regarding standards for outcomes for NC courses and programs. We also plan to initiate a discussion around courses objectives and whether Assessment should be evaluating these.
