Review of BC's Institution Self Evaluation Report (ISER)

- ACCJC in the process of reviewing new standards.
- Recommendation from ACCJC liaison to shift to new standards but would require agreement among all 3 KCCCD colleges. Note: all are on board, therefore will move forward with new standards.
- Moving to new standards means:
 - Fewer standards to write to: 127 down to about 30
 - Sections focus upon analysis (not evidence meeting the standard and analysis of evaluation)
 - No QFE
 - Revised Data Prelude
 - Shift to an 8 year cycle
- Everyone is encouraged to look at proposed [new standards](#), which will be finalized by June.
- ACCJC has accepted substantive change application for 3rd baccalaureate degree!

Review of BC's Institution Set Standards (ISS)

- Some ISS's are slipping, it is up to AIQ to provide recommendation to college on how to proceed.
- Focusing on Course success rates. Average credit success rates have dipped below 69% during last 3 years. Online has been significantly low, CTE may be next.
- Impacts of COVID on majority/preferred modality.
- Exploring Online tools to track course success rates.
- Will share OIE summary and recommendations, once AIQ has reviewed fully and can provide recommendations, as well.
