Announcements:

- Safety Concern was received for removal of pride flags from the counseling department. Found and fixed entrance door without card access.
- Student Health has created Narcan training that can be requested from departments wanting to have Narcan nearby. After training it will be issued to the department manager and stored in an accessible location. Completed Items:

- Charge review is completed and has been approved by Academic Senate.

Upcoming Items:

- Night walks are being conducted by College Safety for Campus and Center Locations to assess any lighting/safety issue.
- Bollards to prevent vehicles on campus interior. M&O has the project. This project has been modified to change from bollards to a gate type infrastructure to allow easier access to interior campus when needed. Calvin is working to secure funding.
- Review of emergency response procedures. Rough draft has been received from outside vendor and are working through it with CC and PC.
- Emergency Response Plan lockdown training exercise is planned for February.
- AED's – Currently there are eight on campus with 40 on order along with new signage. They should be here before the end of the semester.
- Great Shakeout revealed possible changes to evacuation locations. Updating Red Bag procedures and possibly including radios to red bag.
