Review of committee work for 2023-24

BC and KCCD Services Survey

- The survey was conducted in Fall 2023. Results were shared with both academic senate and college council Spring 2024.
- There was discussion about the ability to provide longitudinal data if AIQ revises the survey each year. Unfortunately, changes were unavoidable as ACCJC adopted new accreditation standards effective June 2023. It is the intention of AIQ to have no substantive changes moving forward, unless otherwise needed for accreditation purposes.

Institution Self Evaluation Report (ISER)

- The ISER team are in the final stages of editing and evidence indexing.
- The ISER will be ready for campus review beginning Fall 2024. This will include campus open forums, reviews at college committees, and review/approval from the Board of Trustees.
- The ISER is due to ACCJC, December 2024. The peer review team will review the ISER during Spring 2025, and a campus visit will take place Fall 2025.

Institution Set Standards (ISS)

- Focused on process for establishing ISS and aspirational goals. AIQ has officially approved a process document to publish to our site. Unofficially we have been following these processes since Dean Craig Hayward proposed them as early as 2018.
- Recommendations for inclusion of persistence ISS. AIQ voted to set ISS by using degree/transfer student journey type data as the metric looking at fall to spring and fall to fall ISS. Will bring AIQ recommendations for this addition to academic senate and college council beginning of Fall 2024.
 - *Fall to spring*: with a five-year average of 69%, would be ISS, the standard deviation is 4 so aspirational goal would be 73%.
 - *Fall to fall*: five-year average of 52% would be ISS, and 56% would be aspirational goal

Strategic Directions 2021-24 Report

- BC's 3-year Strategic Directions cycle (2021-24) is concluding this term, Manny Mourtzanos and Kristin Rabe presented updates on the 73 initiatives.
 - Leads have provided some evidence, completion, and a narrative which have been included in the SD document. VP Rice and Manny in discussion about the next 3 years of SD along with President Fliger.
 - Received 100% response on scores
 - Not started yet = 1
 - In progress = 47
 - Complete = 25
 - Not reported = 0
