- Interior Campus Vehicular Safety
 - The campus gates project is waiting on paperwork that must be cleared. These will be built by our welding department students led by Jeremy Statt.
 - The bollards project has been funded and is planned to be completed this summer with outside contractors.
- Clearly Compliance is underway with gathering reports from local law enforcement. Due on October 1st, planning for draft by June.
- Campus Sworn Officers Update: Report is positive and is pending Board Approval which may go to the board in May. If approved, the plan is to have 6 officers so there can always be one on the main campus, 24/7/365. Their main role will be to protect our staff and students and will integrate into our campus family.
- Emergency Response Procedures: College Safety met on March 11th, 2025 with all college presidents and reviewed needed security updates on campuses.
