The report includes crime statistics for the previous three calendar years concerning reported crimes that occurred on campus; in certain off-campus buildings or property owned or controlled by Bakersfield College; and on public property within or immediately adjacent to and accessible from the campus. No Fire statistics or Missing Person's statistics are included, as Bakersfield College does not offer student-housing facilities.

The report also includes information and policy statements regarding campus security and safety, for example, crime prevention, security awareness, fire safety drills, alcohol and substance abuse, sexual assault, procedures for reporting a crime and emergency and evacuation procedures, as well as other matters of importance to the campus community. This report has been modified to include the new requirements imposed by the Violence Against Women Reauthorization Act (VAWA) - Campus Sexual Violence Act (SaVE Act) provision, Section 304. Compliance with provisions does not constitute a violation of section 444 of the General Education Provisions Act (20 U.S.C 1232g), commonly known as the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974 (FERPA).
