

SLO-GELO Mapping Instructions

1. Download the SLO-GELO Mapping Form that is posted to the committee website.
2. At the top, enter the course number and title you were assigned (e.g., PHYS B4A – Mechanics and Wave Motion). If you don't know what the title is, you will see it when looking at the COR in step 3.
3. In the first column of the Mapping Table, enter each of the SLOs for the course.
 - a. If you attended the committee meeting, I showed you how to do this. If you didn't attend and aren't sure how to find the current SLOs in eLumen, please refer to the handout I also emailed for viewing a COR in eLumen.
4. Email this partially-filled SLO-GELO Mapping document to the department chair and/or faculty you know would be able to fill out the SLO-GELO mapping. Below is a list of department chairs so you know who to contact.
 - a. If you need a sample text of what to say in the email, use something like "Dear Department Chair, the Assessment Committee is updating SLO to GELO mappings in eLumen. The attached document lists courses and their SLOs that belong to your area. For each SLO, please list the GELOs that match. GELOs are listed in the second attachment. At your earliest convenience, please return the completed document to me and cc Brent Wilson."
5. Please have the completed document sent back to Brent Wilson (brent.wilson@bakersfieldcollege.edu) so mapping can be recorded in eLumen. I will maintain a list of courses that will be marked off as we go.
