### A BILL

#### LEGISLATIVE RESONBIBILITY ACT

1     *Whereas, it is our duty, as an elected body, to be accountable and transparent to our*  
2         *constituency base which includes the student body of Bakersfield College, the community*  
3         *of Bakersfield, Kern County and the State of California;*  
4     *Whereas, various laws are proposed and passed that affect our students and community on*  
5         *a frequent basis;*  
6     *Whereas, the Director of Legislative Affairs is chairman of the Legislative Affairs Committee;*  
7     *Whereas, the Director of Legislative Affairs should stay update with all legislation that is*  
8         *pertinent to the students of Bakersfield College and the surrounding community;*  
9     *Whereas, the students of Bakersfield College deserve an easy ad transparent way to find*  
10         *information regarding the legislation of their Student Government and all of their levels of*  
11         *government;*

13     *Be it enacted by the Senate of the Student Government Association,*

1           a) *The Director of Legislative Affairs will put together a monthly legislative report*  
2           *compiled of College, District, City, County, State and Federal legislation that could*  
3           *possibility affect Bakersfield College, the Kern Community College District, and all of*  
4           *our student population;*

5           *Be it further enacted by the Senate of the Student Government Association,*

6           a) *In order to maintain the highest level of transparency, the Director of Legislative*  
7           *Affairs will be present in monthly "Town Hall" meetings where he or she will give an*  
8           *update on the legislative issues that are of importance and relevance to the our*  
9           *student population and to answer any questions from our students constituents*  
10          *regarding upcoming or current legislative policy.*
