Is data provided to support the discussion? c. Is the discussion of the program's goals for the next three years clear and complete? d. Is data provided to support the discussion?			
6. Curricular Revisions (Instructional Programs only) Is the discussion of curriculum changes clear?			
7. Faculty and Staff Engagement Does the discussion provide data to support the evidence of faculty and staff participation?			
8. Program Funding Sources (if applicable) Has the table been completed?
