#### Enrollments

- We have increased our sophistication in how we manage enrollment
- Analysis and reconciliation between IR FTES report and the 320 report
- Preliminary thinking is a growth of 400 FTES in fall, 400 FTES in spring, and large effort to increase summer
- Focus on enrolling waitlisted students in late start classes beginning on September 18 and October 16

#### Board of Trustees

#### Statewide issues

- 150 million dollar request from CCCCCO for Guided Pathways has been approved; implementation is rolling out; series of workshops this fall and asking schools to send teams; BC is focused on sending teams to statewide workshops on October 2 and October 20
- Governor is calling for the creation of a community college that is completely online targeting working adults that have some college and no credentials;
  - Task force met last week and four options being considered; Arizona State University and Western Governors University as consultants
    - Stand-alone online only college
    - Private vendor and providing credentials based on competencies
    - Collaboration among CA Community Colleges already providing online programs
  - Faculty trained in the online rubric; using statewide rubric and courses are CID approved then college
  - OEI exchange is opened spring 2017; students can use it only after exhausting options at local college

- CSU Executive Orders
  - CSU is change placement requirement; administering multiple measures

- Department of Public Safety is working closely with SGA, and have developed a plan that will go the Board of Trustees on September; this plan provides options for the Board to consider

- SGA president understands financial hardship for students, and has emphasized the importance of safety. SGA supports the parking fee

- Chapter 2 has been completed based on the CCLC
  - AP2340, AP2435, and BP 2436, delegation authority to Chancellor and president and evaluation; will go back to Board for further review
  - Senate provided language asking for evaluations of these positions to include input from various constituency groups

- Chapter 7
  - BP770 – responsible employees language has been removed
  - Mandatory Reporting
- Budget Matters
  - 5 additional positions have been requested; two for IT, two for HR and one in Business Services
  - Adjusted the budget by \$400,000 to allow for ongoing software and programs already in affect
  - District Office will not move forward with hiring IR Director
- Additional discussion began on Strategic Directions

  - ISIT is the governance group with oversight of this document
  - This is a three year plan; high level document that begins with overview of technology
  - College Council will review and take action at Sept 15 meeting
- Summer Projects
- Measure J Wireless Project
  - Scope: To provide wireless coverage to all internal building spaces at BC and Delano. This will provide an additional 250+ access points across the campus.
  - Status: Contractor has been identified; scheduling to start surveying the site and drawing up plans for the upgrades.
  - Timeline: The current target is to have the work begin by Summer 2018.
- Starfish: tabled to Sept 15
- E-lumen and Canvass: tabled to Sept 15
