# Welcome and Overview of Agenda

## **President's Report**

- Emerging understanding of 320 Report will impact district allocation model
  - o Budget Committee looking into this in detail
  - o Adjusted BC FTES targets to 1000
  - o Adjusted allocation to Bakersfield College for 2017-18
  - KCCD has highest reserve level in the state at 38%
- Board of Trustees, September 15, 2017
  - o DACA Response Team Efforts

## **Annual Evaluation of College Council**

Fulks directed the Council to documents posted and referenced the <u>analysis of the 2015-16 to the 2016-17 results.</u>

- Reminder to focus on the continuous evaluation our work and improve our services to students; College Council has the oversight and responsibility for this evaluation to occur
  - Response rate is 90% or higher for each survey question
  - o Manageable work plan increased by 23%

- o 95% of responses agreed with the effectives of College Council
- Professional Development: perhaps use structure of larger meeting to focus on specific topics

Christian made note that information on the College's websites needs updating. The committee webpages are one piece of the larger project.

  - o Highly Recommended Information

College Council is responsible for oversight and accountability of the maintenance and integrity of our committee webpages

  - O District Office budget has increased by 4.8million dollars. BC's charge back is 4.6million dollars.
