GRANTS AND PROJECTS

- CCPT1 (Wonderful Ag Pathway)
 - Grant funding has expired. Bakersfield College will continue collaboration and support of the pathway. Graduating first cohort at Wonderful College Prep Academy.
 - Summer 2018 through Summer 2019- 66 sections
 - Supporting non-ag pathway students (liberal arts) with pathway.
 - Summer 2018 through Summer 2019- 44 sections
 - Remaining funding just for summer camps.

GRANTS AND PROJECTS

- Adult Education Block Grant (AEBG)
 - Funding has been established as on-going (will not be categorized as grant)
 - North Kern Adult Education (Delano)- \$357,000/year
 - South Kern (Bakersfield)- \$250,000/year
 - Funding plan includes marketing of BC EMLS, Basic Skills, and CTE programs.
 - Can purchase technology, books, and other instructional materials.
 - Can support establishment of programs which create seamless transitions from adult school to college.
 - Currently running advertising campaign on Univision for EMLS.
 - Provide academic liaisons, advisors, and tutors at adult school sites on a daily basis who provide support to potential BC students. Provide academic support as well as technical assistance with matriculation.


- Game Changer, Early College Project, and RIDE
 - Provide on site BC counselor to support students in different pathways.
 - Will utilize interactive classroom (RIDE) to stream courses that support Game Changer and Early College Project.
 - Early College Project concurrent classes launching Spring 2018- About 70 students will be taking Comm B1 class.

BAKERSFIELD COLLEGE-DELANO CAMPUS RANDOLPH SITE FACILITY

 Bakersfield College (BC) has reacquired the use of facilities located at 1942 Randolph St. The facilities include the original Bakersfield College-Delano administration and classroom building. The additions of modular classrooms, gym/multipurpose building, and outdoor recreational areas made by the Wonderful College Prep Academy are also now part of the BC





LIMITED USE AT RANDOLPH FACILITY

- The Randolph site has over 30 classrooms.
- Bakersfield College is currently only able to use two of those classrooms in order to keep in line with state funding.
- Bakersfield College is unable to use the gym/multi-purpose building for instruction due to a lack of DSA approval. Update to make the building DSA compliant would cost \$860,000.

























BAKERSFIELD COLLEGE @ RANDOLPH SITE

- Plan was two convert one available classroom into an HVAC lab.
- Would cost \$250,000 to create the lab.
- There is also a discussion of potentially launching a physical therapy program which would require some updating to the other classroom.
- Would require additional staff to operate the facility (for use of two classrooms).
- Additional cost of maintenance, landscaping, technology and security update.

PREFERRED OUTCOME FOR BAKERSFIELD COLLEGE

- Keep all operations on the Timmons Ave location, as well as at shared use facilities at Robert F. Kennedy HS.
- DJUHSD moving district operations to BC Randolph site would open up CTE space at RFK HS for BC use. (Would include opportunity for continued partnership with high school for CTE programs)
- More efficient to manage facilities and operations adjacent to Timmons campus instead of at a second campus at Randolph site.
