The Accreditation & Institutional Quality (AIQ) committee will meet next on Tuesday, March 6, 2018, at 3:30 pm in Levinson 40.

Accreditation:

- Bakersfield College was well-represented at the ASCCC Accreditation Institute on February 23-24. Accreditation faculty lead Jason Stratton, Curriculum Co-Chair Jennifer Johnson, Dean Billie Jo Rice, and Jessica Wojtysiak attended. We met briefly with Gohar Momjian, the ACCJC Vice President assigned to serve as our liaison during our Fall, 2018 site visit.
- BC was also well-represented at the ACCJC Team Training Workshop held on February 8<sup>th</sup>. Each of the teams being trained that day included at least one person from BC: Sonya Christian, Lesley Bonds, Bill Moseley, Don Chrusciel, and Jessica Wojtysiak. Our very own Janet Fulks helped lead the training day.
- AIQ will be opening the Spring 2018 Bakersfield College Services Survey next week. Jason Stratton will email out a link to the SurveyMonkey site. The survey was last distributed in 2016, and the 2018 survey replicates the previous survey's questions, updated for organizational changes. Please complete the survey by Spring Break.
