

President's Report to College Council

Spring 2019 Enrollment:

The November 15, 2018 (2nd week of priority registration) enrollment update from Institutional Research shows:

Districtwide – headcount decreased by 87 (-0.7%), total number of enrollments increased by 393 (1.1%), FTES decreased by 26 (-0.5%), and waitlisted enrollments increased by 354 (14%).

BC – headcount increased by 130 (1.4%), total number of enrollments increased by 893 (3%), FTES increased by 27 (0.7%), and waitlisted enrollments increased by 195 (9%).
