Fall 2019 Enrollment:

The September 4, 2019 enrollment update from Institutional Research shows:

- Enrollment at BC for fall 2019 is 6.1% higher than the same time last fall which is a **449.6 FTES increase** this fall over last fall.

Baccalaureate Attainment in California

BC has developed a brief concept paper (see attached) to address baccalaureate attainment statewide beginning with a partnership with CSUB. To increase baccalaureate graduates, BC proposes that CSUB increase its proportion of transfer students from approximately 40% to 60% of their overall student population while expanding masters-level programs. This shift will lead to an increase in timely completion, greater equity in completion, and economic value.

Statewide Work

In July, the CCCCO honored BC for its implementation of Guided Pathways and the Completion Coaching Community Structure with the 2019 Dr. John W. Rice Award.

BC has expanded the Program Pathways Mapper to include a pilot with UCLA displaying BC's STEM programs in Biology, Chemistry, Physics, and Computer Science. The total number of credits associated with the degrees for these UC STEM transfers exceed 60 units; however, the Mapper provides greater clarity in the course sequencing. Over 30 California community colleges are using the Program Mapper with more in the queue to begin implementation.
