Social Distancing and Sanitation Recommendations for Face to Face Courses

- Temperature check is recommended prior to entry into classroom
 - Any student with a fever of > 100.4 will not be allowed into the classroom (this assumes that we have thermometers available)
 - o Students must adhere to CDC guidelines for personal health requirements
- Students must wash hands prior to entry into classroom (this requires us to have handwashing stations readily available)
- Student must always wear a cloth covering/mask while in the classroom setting
 - Students must refrain from touching mask and/or face
 - o Students must wash hands before removing face covering
 - o Do not use a facemask intended for healthcare personnel
- Students, faculty and staff must maintain at least 6 feet of distance between each other
- If using a variety of equipment while in the classroom setting students must wash hands before and after equipment use
- Students and faculty must sanitize equipment at the end of each class session
- Students must wash hands before leaving classroom
- Students to not remove face coverings until they have left campus
- It is not recommended to wear gloves

Classroom Sanitation Requirements

- The classroom must be well ventilated recommend keeping doors and windows open
- M&O to clean/sanitize classroom between each class period
- Faculty and students to sanitize equipment at the end of each class session
- Space utilization to maintain social distancing requirement must be calculated based on people per square foot of classroom (M&O will determine allowable number of students)

Syllabus statement for Social Distancing in the Classroom

Bakersfield College is committed to minimizing the risk of transmission of COVID-19. In order to move select courses back on to the campus, the following steps will be implemented for this course:

- All students will be required to have a temperature check upon entry into the classroom
 - Students must adhere to CDC guidelines for personal health requirements, any student with a fever of > 100.4 will not be allowed into the classroom
- Students must wash hands prior to entry into classroom
- Student must always wear a cloth covering/mask while in the classroom setting
 - o Students must refrain from touching mask and/or face
 - Students must wash hands before removing face covering
 - o Do not use a facemask intended for healthcare personnel
- Students, faculty and staff must maintain at least 6 feet of distance between each other
- If using a variety of equipment while in the classroom setting students must wash hands before and after equipment use
- Students and faculty will be required to sanitize any equipment used at the end of each class session
- Students must wash hands before leaving classroom
- Students will not remove face coverings until they have left campus
- It is not recommended that students or faculty wear gloves
