 - KCCCD anticipates two allocations
 - Use of funds will be up to each college
 - New funding will allow us to compensate for lost revenue, as well as for expenses incurred
 - The funds received from the state/federal COVID block grant have primarily been expended, as well as funding from the CARES Act.
