The Pest Control Adviser Preparation program will prepare students for a wide variety of entry-level positions related to pest identification, prevention, control methods and applications of crop protection materials. Pest Control Advisers (PCAs) are licensed professional production consultants who serve California agriculture, natural resource and horticulture producers. PCAs specialize in pest management, but they are also an important resource to producers in a wide range of production concerns related to plant health. This program prepares candidates for the California State Agricultural Pest Control Adviser (PCA) License examinations and Qualified Applicator License (QAL) exams. The courses meet the minimum educational qualifications, and prepares students for exams in IPM principles, laws and regulations, pest identification, physical and biological sciences, crop health, pest management systems and methods, and production systems. In addition to completing the course work with a 2.0 grade point average or better, the California Department of Pesticide Regulation requiries PCA license exam applicants to have completed 24 months of technical work experience before taking the exam.
