Curriculum Committee Meeting

March 23, 2023, 2:30-4:00 PM

C-ID Updates: Public Health will have a substantive update, expected in Fall 2023. 19 more disciplines are under review. An Ethnic Studies TMC is coming. Potential futures TMCs that are being reviewed include Women's/Gender Studies and Music Industry Studies. The feasibility of a Graphic Design TMC is being assessed. CCC and CSU faculty needed to review disciplines. A request will be emailed to all faculty.

ASCCC Updates: Area A meeting is March 24th. Spring 2023 Plenary is April 20th to 22nd. The Resolutions packet and information can be found on the [Resolutions Spring 2023 ASCCC page](#). As of March 17th, there are no resolutions directly impacting articulation or transfer. Reach out to our ASCCC Delegate, [Dr. Christine Cruz-Boone](#), with questions, concerns, and/or voting preferences.

Legislative Updates: New legislation that is being considered related to articulation and transfer include [AB 506/AB 654](#) Ethnic Studies Articulation, [AB 1390](#) CSU Graduation Requirement – Service Learning, and [AB 811](#) Repeatability.

ASSIST Updates: ASSIST is in the middle of an Articulation Modernization Project. This includes increasing functionality, improving the user experience, and including more articulation options. The Association of Independent California Colleges and Universities (AICCU) will be added and California Community Colleges with Bachelor's Degree Programs (BDPs).

ADT Substitution Form: A new ADT substitution form will be available for students starting in Fall 2023 using the IGETC GE Pattern.

CSU GEAC Updates: The CSU Chancellor's General Education Advisory Committee is discussing the American Institution Requirement and possible requests to move the or duplicate the requirement at the upper division level. We are awaiting official recognition of GE credit for new AP tests: Pre-Calculus and African American Studies.

GE Team Recommendations: Review the attached GE Team report for the recommendations and feedback on courses requesting any form of General Education.
