	<ul> <li>Establishing ISS goals in line with the VfS using Chancellor's data for ADT completion and units at degree award</li> <li>Discussion about data definition regarding units at degree award: is the definition only for students who have completed a degree or is it related to the goal declaration?</li> <li>Hayward clarified that students' units only count if they earn an associate's degree so the definition only considers completers</li> <li>Leighton asked about lifelong learners who come back to the college after having earned an associate's degree. Hayward clarified it is only units earned or accumulated at time of the degree.</li> <li>Hayward: units from other colleges do not count, with the exception of in-district units (i.e. those that come from Cerro Coso or Porterville)</li> <li>Bonds question re: accountability. Hayward shared that Chancellor's Office accountability will be public availability of the data which will be reviewed by BOT</li> <li>Bonds recommended the disaggregation of all VfS goals to address goal #5 and develop more aggressive goals for smaller student populations (i.e. African American students have higher unit accumulation but the goal can be more aggressive due to the size of the cohort)</li> <li>OIE agreed to create a Tableau dashboard to disaggregate all VfS goals.</li> </ul>
