Challenges:

- Trying to get 100% of Education faculty on board with using Starfish. Starfish training to be held at our next Education Pathway meeting
- Math completion
- Survey sent to all students in Education Pathway
- Most responded that either 1) "There was not an open section that fit their schedule." or
 2) "I did not want to take math yet, so I am waiting to take it later."
- Cannot predict how many students need MATH B75 or MATH B70 or MATH B72 before taking the transfer level math.
- Increase wait-list sizes for MATH B4A to see which times/days students prefer.
- Kathleen Rush will come next meeting to brainstorm possible solutions for students putting off Math requirement.
