

Health Science Pathway November Update

Meeting held Nov 26, 2019

- Continue to seek out a Data coach. No response from previous requests to locate our data coach.
 - **ACTION**-Harding will email Lesley Bonds to get help in assigning a data coach.
- Discussed the completion coaching teams. Need to emphasize the request for biology to attend meeting to discuss concerns with A&P and other bio courses within the pathway
 - Request for a stand alone Anatomy vs Physiology course and not integrated
 - Kinesiology and other Pathway majors have students that struggle to complete A&P as it is very nursing focused. Need to collaborate with Bio, to assist other students to be successful.
 - **ACTION**- Harding will email Joe Saldivar to request a faculty to attend the GPIT HS meetings when possible.
- First Aid/CPR course offered by Public Safety is confusing students. They are taking a one day course expecting it to meet the standard for the 3 unit course in PE.
 - ACTION-Harding will email NickyD to inquire re better description in the one day course to avoid confusion
 - **FOLLOW UP**- Harding worked with Reggie to get a description/disclaimer to pair with future announcements of the Public Safety offered one-day course.
 - First aid course is no longer accepted in area E as a gen ed course
 - **ACTION**- Need to follow up with Assessment committee to clarify expectations and return course as Area E.
 - **ACTION**-Plan to invite Mark Osea and Brent Wilson to next meeting to assist with concern re meeting Area E requirements for course.
- Occupational Safety-Catherine Jones will make changes in description of OSRM for the brochure, submitted a nice one page handout that describes her program Pathway that lists when each course is offered as some are only once a year.
- Health Science Pathway/Health Careers course update- Jennifer Johnson is leading work-group to finalize the course and get it ready to submit to curriculum. Meeting to take place week of December 2, 2019.
 - **ACTION**-Jennifer Johnson will update status on health careers course at next meeting.

- Health Science Brochure- has been located, reviewed by group. Some items in "Career areas" need to be removed, others added. Need to determine the purpose of the brochure as well as the audience. If a student at BC wants to learn more about the pathway, there is no information for that.
 - **ACTION**- Harding will attempt to determine who/where/what and why regarding the brochure. All members to review and bring back feedback on brochure once determined audience and purpose.
- Next meeting to be held in February. Will send out Doodle poll to determine availability for most stakeholders.
