Tracking Items Raised from Progress Reports

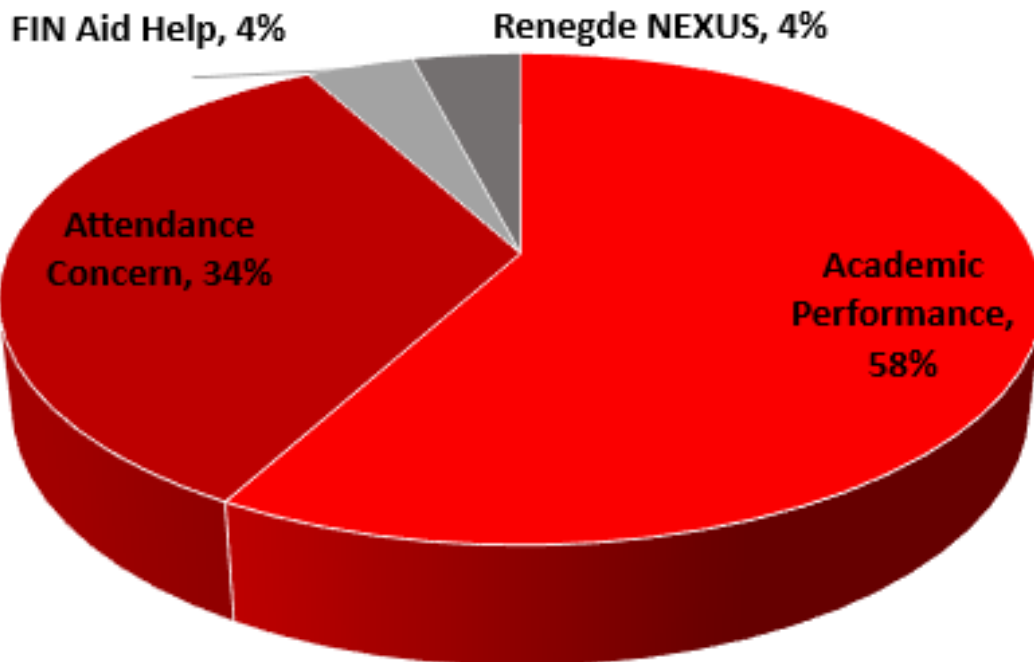
Student Tracking Items

In past terms using Progress reports across campus, incremental increases in Progress Report completion has been seen from survey to survey. This Spring we start the term off with PST, BS, and ANC leading the charts with the highest completion rates at 56%, 44%, and 35% completion.

As a recap, from the Surveys that are submitted, tracking items are raised for certain students. Some students are referred to valuable BC resources such as tutoring, writing center help, or other resources and some are sent a Kudo in recognition of their hard work.

Below you will see a breakdown of all flags and referrals initiated from each Progress Report of the term. *Keep in mind that Kuddos are typically our number one item sent out to students.

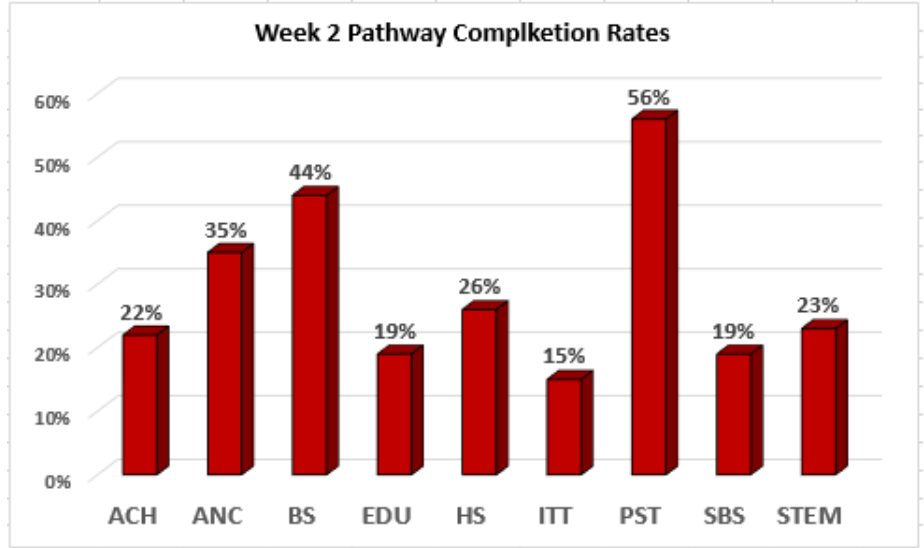
Week 2 Tracking Items raised

When the data is broken down to observe a pathway view, you can see how completion rates compare by pathway.



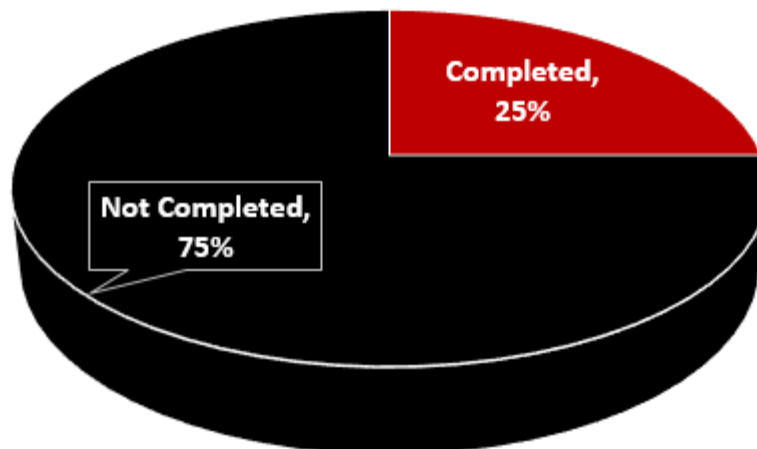

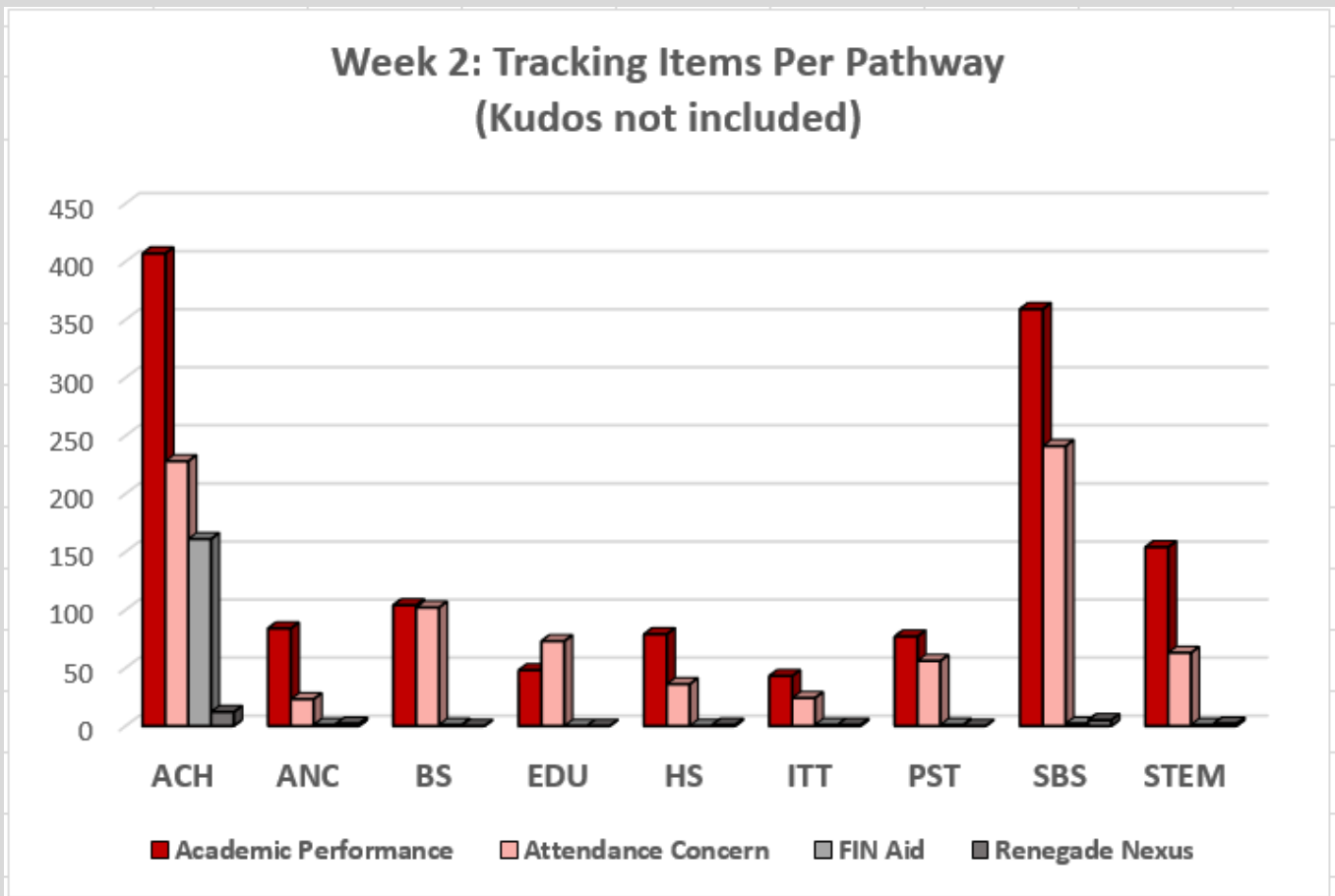
